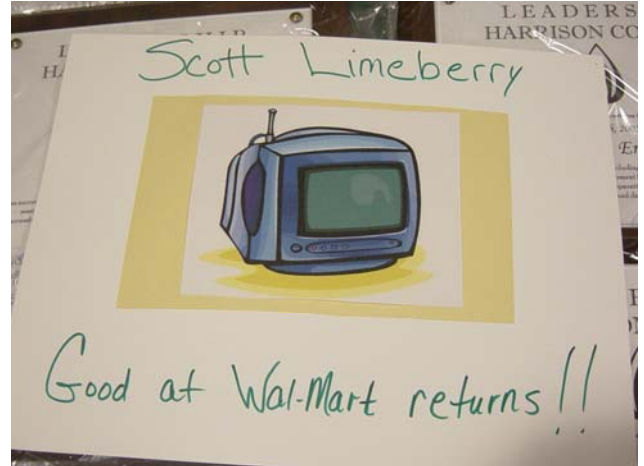

# Marvelous Maxine: Servant Leader of 2004-2005

Servant Leadership. It's a phrase most, if not all, of us have heard but would perhaps fumble over defining. But during the past seven months those of us in the Leadership class have learned more about it & should have a better grasp of what it means.

Robert Greenleaf, the man who coined the phrase, described it this way: "The servant-leader is servant first. It begins with the natural feeling that one wants to serve, to serve first. Then conscious choice brings one to aspire to lead . . ."

We might say it's a person who serves out of a personal mission & understands the power of vision. A person who's inclusive,

empowers others & acts as a trustee.

When you look at past recipients, you can readily see these characteristics, especially how they have exemplified the giving of one's self. Maxine is no different.

After graduating from Corydon Central, Maxine pursued a post-secondary degree at Roosevelt University in Chicago. From Chicago, she relocated closer to home, working with the Indianapolis Public School System's remedial education program as a program officer for Lilly Endowment and was executive vice president of the Kentucky Foundation for Women. In 1987 she returned to live in Corydon.

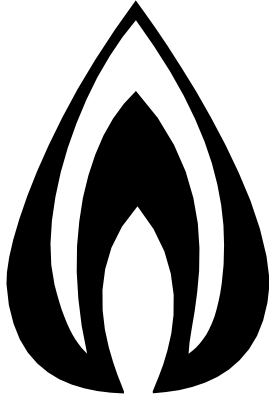
In 1990, she started a new group—NETWORK—New Energy To Work Out Racial Kinks. Maxine has served on the Board of Trustees for Indiana University Southeast, co-chaired a panel for former Louisville Mayor Dave Armstrong designed to help with racial tensions in that city & has worked to form a regional chapter of the Indiana Junior Historical Society so children can learn more about the history of their communities.
